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Expense Budget Summary Description

The School Department allocates its expense budget in various programmatic categories as outlined in the FY2019 Expense Budget Detail Table. Each expense budget line has a budget manager assigned who is responsible for the oversight and management of the budget. The School Department annually identifies new expenses that fall into three categories; legally mandated, enrollment, and program improvements when determining potential increases to the expense budget.

Additionally, program/building-based expense budgets are adjusted for enrollment changes using a per pupil expenditure rate, which is also then adjusted by the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Non-program and District-wide focused budgets are only adjusted by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) to account for inflationary factors. The FY2019 budget does not include a CPI adjustment. The FY2019 expense per-pupil budget is assembled using the October 1, 2017 enrollment data reported to the state.

A table is inserted below highlighting the enrollment data used to calculate the FY2019 expense budgets subject to per-pupil expenditure adjustments. It should be noted an adjustment is made in the second column (“Adjusted Oct 1, 2017 enrollment for FY19 budget”) for Harrington to accommodate Lexington Children’s Place being located in the building and its indirect impact on general building operations and supply ordering.
