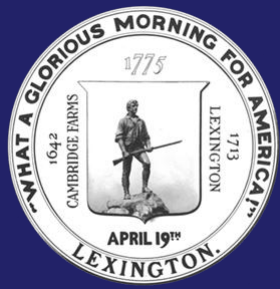

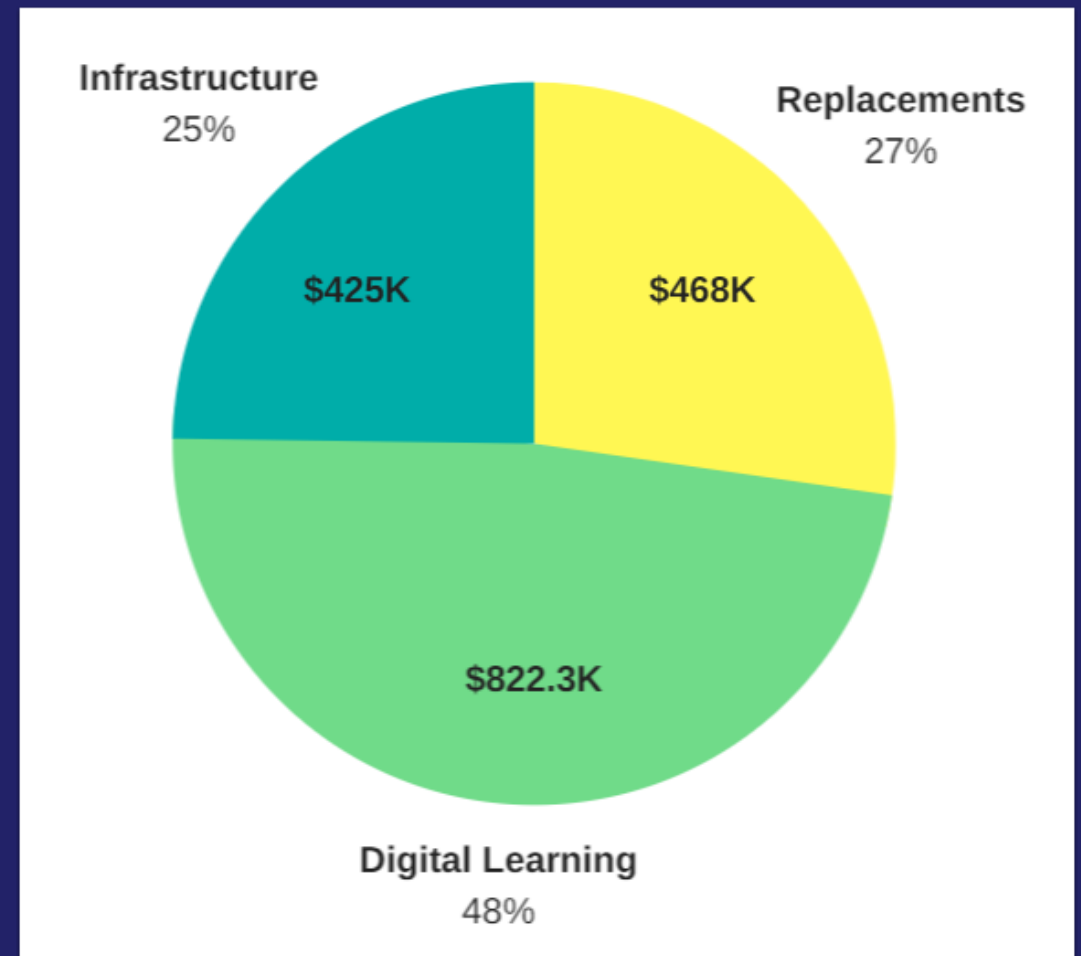


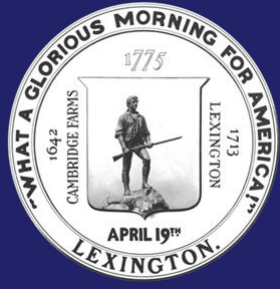
FY2019 Budget – School Technology Capital

- Digital Learning Initiatives

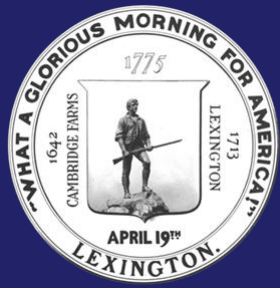




FY2019 Budget – School Technology Capital

- Network Infrastructure Upgrades
\$425,000
 - Wireless Access Points
 - Replace Switches (end of life)
 - Storage/Server Environment
- Replacement of Existing Technology
\$468,000
 - Replacement of Staff Devices
 - Replacement of older iPads
 - Replacement of Interactive Whiteboards

\$822,300

- Elementary Schools
 - Increase Classroom access to mobile devices
 - Integrate robotics
 - Update technology in Media Centers
- Middle & High Schools
