This opportunity is perfect for those who love fresh local food and enjoy interacting with the public. Knowledge of the LFM is ideal, but not necessary (you will learn!) Training is provided.

You will be asked to volunteer a minimum of six-3 hour sessions during our May-October season. Work is outside, rain or shine.

If you have any special market ideas or artistic skills you would like to share, we are always looking to think of fun new LFM activities.

We will need 2 volunteers per shift, one of whom will need to be able to list and carry tents.

There will always be a market manager on site with you.

1:00

Meet market manager on site, on the corner of Fletcher Ave and Mass Ave.

Unload tables and tents from managers car onto market site, set up, and stake down.

Put sandwich board on bike path, fill water tank, and set up specific daily needs.

2:00 ring bell to open market!

2:00-6:30

Count and record visitor attendance, cover farmer/vendor tents when needed for bathroom breaks, and answer basic market questions. Occasionally you will be asked to assist in a craft project with kids, ask customers survey questions, and sell LFM aprons.

6:30 ring bell to close market

6:30-7 Break down market setup, load cars, and return material to storage area.
